They will enjoy the fruits of their labor and make nutritious snacks. Churn ice cream the old-fashioned way and gain the confidence and self esteem that comes from farming tasks. At the end of a successful week the children will receive a certificate showing they are an **Auer Farm Academy Graduate**.
