❑ **Rock & Roll Ice Cream (all ages)**

Make your own ice cream with an old-fashioned hand-cranked churn.

❑ **Nutrition in Action (2nd – 6th)**

Explore the relationship of diet and exercise in a choice of 2 lessons.

❑ **Seeds (Pre-k to 3rd)**

Learn about planting seeds and create a homemade greenhouse.

❑ **Chickens and Eggs (K – 6th)**

Chick embryology is taught with the help of a little feathered friend.

❑ **Food, Land and People (K – 8th)**

Examine how agriculture and environment work together to feed, clothe and house people.

❑ **Biotechnology in Agriculture (6th – 8th)**

Learn about nutrition and how food gets from the farm to the table.

❑ **Our Genes Make Us Unique (3rd – 5th)**

Understand how everyone is unique although they share physical characteristics.

❑ **Traveling Barnyard (Pre-k to 2nd)**

A live rabbit and chicken come to help you learn about animal anatomy and how their senses differ.

❑ **Nature's Digest (3rd -6th)**

Dissect a real owl pellet and find out why the barn owl is the farmer's best friend.
